First Aid Kit	Each vehicle will carry a first aid kit.		
Insurance	Proof of vehicle liability insurance required – no exceptions. No proof – no

Garbage	out including cigarette butts. Trail riders are encouraged to pick up any trash they	\

Recovery Gear	Each vehicle shall be equipped with a rated recovery rope or strap. Should be		
	rated appropriately for the weight of vehicle. No damage shall be present. Screw	11

Roll Bar	Body mounted roll bars must have backing plates at mounting point.	5	
	Roll bars are required for vehicles with full removable top. (Stock Jeep Sport Cage

Seat & Seat Belts	Seats must be securely mounted. Seat belts are required for all occupants. All

Shoes	No open toed shoes allowed (sandals, flip flops, barefoot, etc).		
Suspension	Must appear safe.		
Tires & Lug nuts	Must have full size spare. Must have all lug nuts installed. U D D		
Tow Points	Required front and rear. OEM or stronger. Class III receiver acceptable. Must		
	appear structurally safe. Must be attached with grade 5 or better, 1/2" or larger		
	bolts. Under no circumstances is chain allowed for vehicle towing.		
Winch	If equipped, must have tree saver strap in vehicle. Winch to be shown functional

Windows	If present must be operable to properly communicate with spotter in recovery		
	situation. All occupants to always keep arms and legs in the vehicle at all times
